Dear Congregation:

On Maundy Thursday there will be a silent supper with grape juice, bread and salt, the gospel will be read at the end. After the silent supper we will do 'washing of feet' for those who wish to partake. It is a very special experience. Please let us know if you'd like to come so that we can lay a place at the table for you.

From 4th – 16th April Siobhán will be away in Spain accompanying a youth group from the Stroud Youth Initiative. They will be staying and volunteering at an Eco-village, an organic/biodynamic self-sufficient community producing, among many things wine, honey and olive oil, and it has its own herd of goats for milk and cheese. There will also be time for swimming and hiking in the mountains. The village is called Los Portales and lies north of Seville.

Ascension Day is on Thursday, 10th May. We plan to have an early morning festival for the children including having breakfast in the garden as we did last year. Everyone is welcome!

In addition to this, ostensibly for the children, but energetic and keen people are welcome to join us, - a mountain ascent- to gain height and a closer look at the clouds. We will go to North Wales to climb Snowdon - the highest mountain in England and Wales. - leaving Friday afternoon (11th May) after school with an overnight stay in Snowdonia, climbing the mountain on the Saturday. On Sunday 24th June, St. John's day, we will celebrate midsummer with Karl König's St. John's play. The play will be

performed at Ashfield gardens, followed by the St. John's fire. There are many roles to play (some are already taken!) and there is definitely a part for every child. There will be acting, bell ringing and singing. Whether you have a specific part or not, all players and the audience can be involved as we all walk and sing together. There is a lot to do to prepare costumes and banners and organise transport and think about food. We hope to find time on Sunday mornings, nearer the time to practise the songs. In this programme 4 people offered to share stories about their lives. This is a special gift to the congregation and we hope there might be more in the next programme.

From July 21-31 there will be a summer camp for 7-14 year olds, held on a bio-dynamic farm near Forest Row. There is a poster with more details on the church noticeboard.
