On Saturday the 4th of July the ban of public worship will be partially lifted. So we will start with the planned service in German 'Die Menschenweihehandlung' at 10.00 am that day.

Then our public services will be celebrated at the usual times:

Sundays 10.00

Tuesdays 8.00

Thursdays 10.00

Children and family services will begin once more.

Due to government regulations there will be some changes:

We will need to space out the chairs, so that there is more distance between people.

We won't be allowed to share communion.

We are not allowed to sing, but hopefully we will have music.

At the entrance to the church and to the community rooms there are bottles of hand sanitizer for your use.

In the toilets there are single use paper hand towels available.

For now we won't serve coffee after the service.

We are not yet allowed to give talks or have gatherings.

Please allow for the '1meter+' distancing before and after the service.

We will wedge open the 2 doors leading into the church before and after the service, so that one can enter and leave the church without having to touch any surface.

There is a detailed risk assessment policy available.
